#### Terms & Conditions:

1. Priority for out-of-season storage is allocated to Swinging Mooring Holders first, then Marina berth holders, followed by date order of request.
2. For members requesting shed storage, allocations are based on dry work priority followed by date of application.
3. It is the responsibility of each Member to ensure that their boat is ready for relaunch by 1<sup>st</sup> April. **Please be aware from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2027 new Haven & Yard schedule of charges will apply.**
4. The Club's Rules and Byelaws which are displayed on the Club's noticeboards and website regarding berthing, mooring and storage are incorporated in this application and will bind the Member applying.
5. The Club will use its reasonable endeavors to honor booked dates.
6. Any claim against the Club or its employees in relation to these activities must be submitted through the insurer of the Member's boat and will normally be dealt with by the Club's insurers.
7. **It is vitally important that the Member advises the RMYC Office of all the work required to be carried out, including Southern Marine Services/Outside contractors (including dates if possible) in order that a program can be prepared for the Yard staff and contractors.**
8. It is mandatory to have a spare set of boat and (if appropriate) trailer keys deposited with the RMYC Office.
9. There is not an automatic retention to keep your boat here. A storage form is required for each season.
